In addition to technical skills, interns were also introduced to social media management and industry practices, helping them become more employable. Alongside this, regular follow-up visits were conducted to offer emotional and social support, helping the children cope with their loss and regain a sense of stability.



This intervention not only addressed their urgent nutritional needs but also restored hope for their future, particularly in terms of continuing their education and living with dignity.



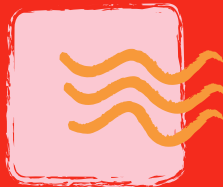
Community Welfare Activities

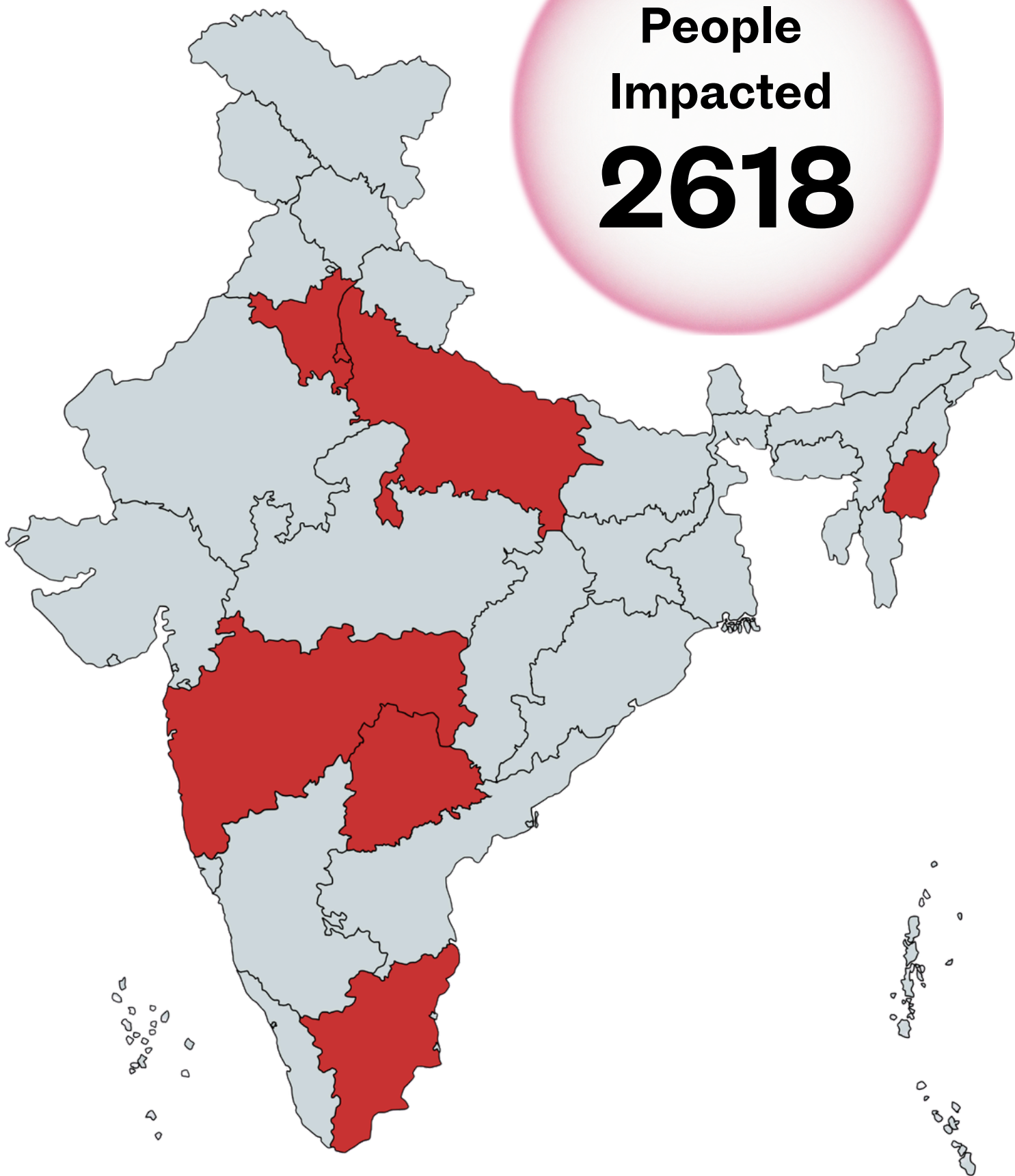

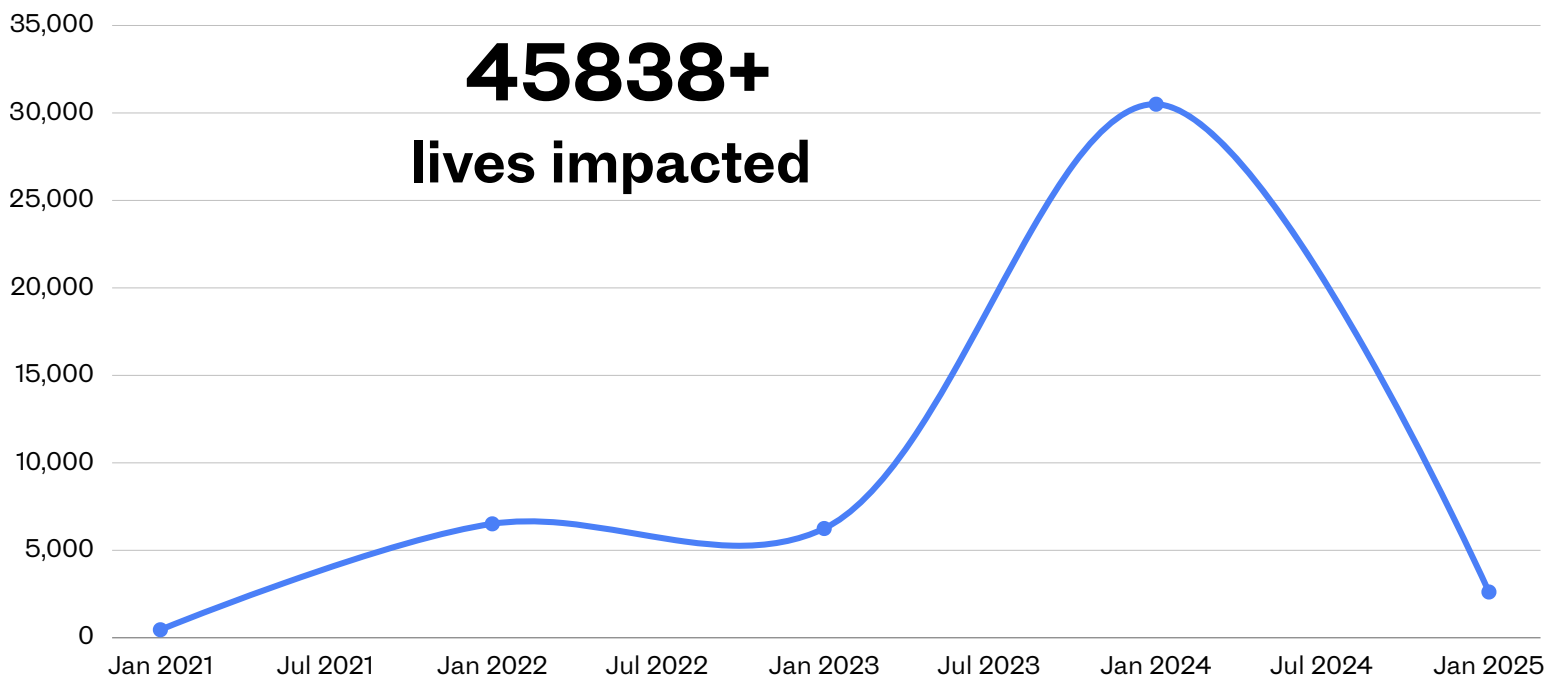
